1. Company overview

SABIC is a global leader in diversified chemicals headquartered in Riyadh, Saudi Arabia. It manufactures on a global scale in the Americas, Europe, Middle East and Asia Pacific, making distinctly different kinds of products: chemicals, commodity and high performance plastics, agri-nutrients and metals.

The company has more than 32,000 employees worldwide and operates in around 50 countries, with innovation hubs in five key geographies – USA, Europe, Middle East, South East Asia and North East Asia. SABIC is one of the largest diversified chemical companies in the world.

SABIC is a public company based in Riyadh, Saudi Arabia. 70% of the Company’s shares are owned by Saudi Aramco, with the remaining 30% publicly traded on the Saudi stock exchange.

SABIC’s global presence continues to grow rapidly. Its ambitious plans for expansion are matched by the development of an infrastructure of manufacturing plants, technology centers, distribution centers, offices and storage facilities worldwide.

2. Our Business

SABIC operates through three strategic business units (SBUs) and metals (Hadeed):

Petrochemicals

We make the essential chemical building blocks for materials used in everything from packaging to healthcare to household goods.

Agri-nutrients

Our fertilizers and specialty agri-nutrients help meet the world’s ever-growing need for food.

Specialties

We produce a wide range of specialty materials from engineering thermoplastic resins to additive manufacturing solutions.

Metals

Our high quality metals have been key to the construction of some of the world’s fastest growing economies.

SABIC’s Business Units support customers by identifying and developing opportunities in key end markets such as **construction, medical devices, packaging, agri-nutrients, electrical and electronics, transportation and clean energy.**

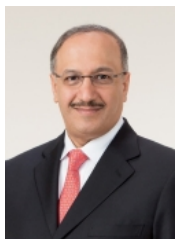

YOUSSEF ABDULLAH AL-BENYAN
SABIC VICE CHAIRMAN & CEO

Mr. Al-Benyan joined SABIC in 1987, just eleven years after the company's formation. His first role was as a business development specialist before joining Corporate Communications. Mr. Al-Benyan relocated to Stamford, Connecticut as Operations Manager. In 1994, he became Commercial Manager for SABIC in the USA and Latin America, based in Houston, Texas. In 2002, he was promoted to General Manager of SABIC Asia, headquartered in Singapore. He made significant contributions to SABIC growth in Asia, especially in China.

Mr. Al-Benyan returned to Houston in the fall of 2005 as the General Manager of SABIC Americas. Then, in 2007, he took on the role of General Manager at Fiber Intermediates, before being named in February 2008 to head Corporate Human Resources.

As Chairman of the '1 SABIC' global unification initiative, he reorganized the company's business structure with a new, single, global organization and operating model, moving from a responsive, transactional entity to a proactive, strategic global organization.

In 2013, Mr. Al-Benyan was selected to lead SABIC's Chemicals business, the company's largest unit, and help SABIC achieve its goal of becoming the preferred global leader in chemicals by 2025.

Prior to being named Vice Chairman and Chief Executive Officer, Mr. Al-Benyan also served as Executive Vice President, Corporate Finance and CFO.

Other positions he holds include Chairman of the Gulf Petrochemicals and Chemicals Association (GPCA), Chairman of the Boards at Yanbu National Petrochemical Company (Yansab), the SABIC Agri-Nutrients Company and Nusaned Investment™.

He is a member of the International Business Council of the World Economic Forum and Global Business Council of the Bloomberg Global Forum.

Mr Al-Benyan was selected as Chairman of the Business Twenty (B20), the official G20 dialogue with the business community, during Saudi Arabia's presidency of the G20 in 2020.

He also sits on the Board of Directors of the Boao Forum for Asia (BFA), the International Council of Chemical Associations (ICCA), the Royal Commission for Jubail & Yanbu, and the Saudi Ports Authority. Mr. Al-Benyan is also a member of the King Saud University Advisory Board, as well as a member of the King Fahad University & Minerals International Advisory Board. He is a board member of the King Abdulaziz City for Science and Technology, the National Industrial Clusters Development Program, and an Executive Committee member of the Riyadh Economic Forum at the Riyadh Chamber of Commerce.

Mr. Al-Benyan holds an Economics degree and a master's degree in Industrial Management, in addition to several specialized executive management courses.
